Moral Education

In July 2016, a new Moral Education initiative was launched in the UAE. The Moral Education Programme covers four pillars of teaching and learning: Character and Morality, The Individual and the Community, Civic Studies and Cultural Studies. The four pillars complement one another, using the lens of moral thinking, learning and building character.

Underpinning the curriculum are the thinking, learning and communication skills relevant to the programme, which support development through to Year 13.

Handling and understanding information: collating, synthesising and managing information.

Thinking, solving problems and decision making: reasoning, predicting, hypothesising and finding solutions.

Being creative: being curious, learning from mistakes and developing new ideas and ways of thinking about the world.

Working with others: teamwork, leadership

Managing oneself: working independently, self-motivation, setting own targets and goals, reflection and evaluation.

Moral Education is timetabled for 1 period (50 minutes) per week from Year 2 up to Year 9.

Examples of the topics covered in the programme:

Year 2 – Me and My Family

Year 3 – Self Identity and Working with Others

Year 4 – Me and My World

Year 5 – Growing up and Well-Being

Year 6 – Taking Responsibility for Oneself and Others

Year 7 – Assuming Responsibility

Year 8 - Respect and Tolerance in a Diverse Community

Year 9 – Establishing Positive Relationships.
